(Ph.D, LL.M., LL.B. and B.A., University of Geneva and Cairo University) Dr. Gomaa has a practical and academic legal experience of more than 30 years. He practices in the fields of arbitration, contracts law, treaties, mega infrastructure projects (including PPP), general corporate law and Public International Law. He has been appointed Arbitrator or Counsel in several local and international commercial arbitrations involving both public and private entities relating, *inter alia*, to construction, commercial agencies, acquisition of shares, sale and purchase agreements, shipbuilding and insurance.

Dr. Gomaa was a member of the drafting committee for the current Arbitration Rules of CRCICA. He served for more than twenty years in different legal posts in the Egyptian Foreign Ministry, where he ended his diplomatic career as Deputy Permanent Representative and Legal Adviser of Egypt to the United Nations in New York.

He is formerly a Member, Legal and Technical Commission of the International Seabed Authority and sometime Adjunct Professor of international law at the American University of Cairo and the University of Trento, Italy. He was “Assistant to the Agent” of the Government of Egypt to the Egypt-Israel Arbitration Tribunal for Taba Case, 1987-89 and a member of the Egyptian delegation in the “Taba Talks” between Egypt and Israel, 1985-87 resulting in the *Compromis d’arbitrage*. He represented the League of Arab States before the ICJ in the case of the “Wall” in both the written and oral proceedings, 2003-2004 and drafted the Written Statements of Egypt in the advisory opinion of the ICJ on the “Legality of the threat or use of nuclear weapons”, 1995-1996. Dr. Gomaa is author of many publications in Egypt and abroad, and has been published by Kluwer.
